- 4. How does Simon represent his time period, and in what ways does he challenge the norms of his era?
- 5. How does this story explore the idea of home? Is it a place, a time, or a person?
- 6. What do you think Isla learns about herself—and her own time period —by living in the past?
- 7. How effectively does the author evoke the atmosphere of 1605 England? Were there any details that particularly stood out to you?
- 8. If you were to travel back to 1605, what modern convenience would you miss most?
- 9. Which of the secondary characters did you find most compelling, and why? How important are they to the story as a whole?
- 10. How well did the book balance Isla and Simon's romance with the suspense of the Gunpowder Plot?
- 11. Were you familiar with the real-life events of Guy Fawkes and his coconspirators before reading the book? How did that affect your reading experience?
- 12. Did you find the resolution satisfying—both in terms of the historical plot and Isla and Simon's fates?
